History of Blue Rock Golf Course

Opened to the public in 1962, Blue Rock Golf Course was the result of founder Pete Davenport's vision to bring a championship par three course to New England. Blue Rock's designer and gifted golf course architect Geoffrey Cornish told Pete, "To build a great par three course, an architect has to build the course in deceit. That is, every hole lies to you. That's what we built here." Upon its opening, legendary golfer Francis Ouimet called Blue Rock "the finest thing I've seen of its kind in this country." Today, Pete's son DeWitt Davenport and grandson Christian Davenport carry on the tradition and promise of Blue Rock as a top-rated course.

Blue Rock is a challenging par three course that is expertly maintained by a team of professional groundskeepers and a private staff gardener who look after the extensive grounds and over 100 varieties of perennials. As a course dedicated to protecting and sustaining Cape Cod's natural resources, Blue Rock is a member of the Audubon Society's Cooperative Sanctuary Program. The challenging nature of play and lush, natural beauty of the course's setting always surprise first-time players on the course.

In 2011, *Golf Magazine* named Blue Rock to its list of "Top 10 Par 3 Courses in the Game" for attention to all aspects of course maintenance, unique layout, and presentation. Blue Rock is challenging enough for the experienced golfer yet welcoming and playable for the novice. As Head PGA Golf Professional Patrick Fannon says, "Blue Rock was designed for golfers to play every club in their bag and a different club from each tee. So far, technology has not overcome Cornish's challenge. Golfers new to the course are often surprised at its difficulty, stating that playing Blue Rock takes finesse."

Blue Rock welcomes the public year round; the course is kept in exceptional condition and aims to be the friendliest place to play on Cape Cod. The team at Blue Rock strives to provide members with a "country club feel."



Off-Season Highlights

As we plan for the upcoming season, the staff at Blue Rock is building on our success of the past few years with an eye on the future by maintaining our standing as “The Country’s Finest Par Three.”

The 2010 – 2011 off-season’s tree management project, bunker renovations and additions of stonewalls really enhanced the Blue Rock experience. Now with the winter months closing in on us, reinvesting in the golf course is in the forefront of our minds. PGA Professional Patrick Fannon and GCSAA-certified superintendent Gerry Boucher plan to highlight the scenic vistas that accentuate the beauty of each hole. The redesign of the ladies' tees on the 9th and 18th holes will see the tees moved back into the hill and the teeing ground raised so players will be more level with the green instead of hitting up to an elevated green. We are planning to give the course more of a “Cape Cod” feel by adding native grasses to accentuate and border some of the holes. Our goal is not only to be one of the “Top 10 Par 3 Courses in the Game” but the best par 3 in the game. As a result, golfers will enjoy many years of enhanced course play.

Our PGA Professional Patrick Fannon looks forward to the opportunity to improve the golf course for years to come. He has 32 years’ experience as a competitive golfer, 22 years in the golf industry, and 15 years as a PGA Professional; this year will mark his 10th season as head professional of Blue Rock. Golf is what Pat loves and it shows: in the past 10 years Blue Rock’s membership has quadrupled, the addition of golf carts has opened the course to more golfers and tournaments, and our well-trained staff in and out of the pro-shop is second to none.

Continuing on her career goal of becoming a PGA Professional, Assistant Pro and Golf Course Manager Marybeth Winslow will be heading to Florida this January to attend the PGA business school in Port St. Lucie. Marybeth will also work toward her LPGA membership and continue to pursue golf fitness certifications from the Titleist Performance Institute. Marybeth is looking forward to March 2012 when she begins her second season as head coach of the Dennis–Yarmouth High School Girls’ Golf Team. She has many goals for the season, including improving the skills of her players, being a positive influence by teaching the values and teaching golf rules and etiquette. Marybeth will encourage new girls to experience this great sport and to help grow girls’ golf on Cape Cod. We’re looking forward to her return to Blue Rock early in the spring.
